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MacMini Configuration with JBApp2 OS 15.5.1

Monterey MacMini 2020 M1

The following instructions are to be used only if it is necessary to replace one of the elements of the playback system, principally the MacMini computer:

Setting up your MacMini with OS 12.5.1 Monterey on MacMini 2020 M1:

Connect USB keyboard and mouse
Connect Screen (via HDMI)
Plug InfraRed Remote Sensor into USB-C ports, if provided
Connect to mains

Connect Archive Disk via USB

Start Mac Mini

Select Language (English); Click Forward Arrow
Select Location; Click Continue
Select Keyboard Layout; Click Continue
Select Wi-Fi Network; Click '**Other Network Options**'; Click Continue
When Drop Down window appears, **Click Continue (Skip Wi-Fi Network)**
Data & Privacy; Click Continue
Transfer Information to to This Mac, Select 'From a Mac, Time Machine backup...';
Click Continue
Select 'Time Machine Monterey; Click Continue
Select 'Blondes's Mac mini'; Click Continue
If Drop Down window appears asking to Update Software, Select 'Skip'
Select the Information to Transfer (Check All); Click Continue
Set Password : **blondes** (all lower case), Confirm password
Terms and Conditions; Click Agree
Migration Complete; Click Quit
Enter password (**blondes**)
Sign In with Your Apple ID; Click '**Set Up Later**'; **Click 'Skip'**

Computer Starts
Quit JeffreyBlondes2
Upper right window... 'Get to Know Your Mac; Click on Later; Click on 'Don't Remind Me'
Eject Archive Disk; Disconnect Archive Disk

Remote Buddy Window: 'Accessibility permission needed; Click 'Proceed'
Click 'Open System Preferences'
In Security & Privacy/Privacy/Accessibility:

Click to Unlock; Enter password (**blondes**)
Check box next to 'Remote Buddy'
Click '+' and add the following Apps:

From /Applications:

Automator
TeamViewer
Remote Buddy
WiFiOff
WiFiOn

From /Documents:

JeffreyBlondes2

From /Documents/Software:

Open Film Directory
Open Preferences
Open Keyboard&Network
Close Keyboard&Network
RunQuit JeffreyBlondes2

Check All

In left Panel, Click on 'Full disk Access'
Click '+' and add all of the preceding Apps

Click on General Tab (Security & Privacy/General)
Uncheck 'Disable automatic login'; Enter password (**blondes**)

Desktop & Screen Saver/ Screen Saver; Set to 'Never'
Notifications/

Check 'Turn on Do Not Disturb'; From **02:01 AM to 02:00 AM**

Verify all Alerts are set to 'None' and uncheck all boxes (verify Home and iTunes!)

Bluetooth/ Advanced...; Uncheck 'Allow Bluetooth devices to wake...'

Date & Time/ Unlock,

Uncheck 'Set time zone automatically...'; set to your Time Zone;

Uncheck 'Set date and time automatically...'; set to your Time;

Time Machine/ Uncheck 'Show Time Machine in menu bar'

Network/WiFi/ Connect to Wifi, enter password, check 'remember', check
'Automatically join this network', uncheck 'Ask to join new networks'

Software Update/ click 'Check for Updates'

Click 'Update Now; Ensure the 'Automatically keep my...' button is UNCHECKED

Click 'Download & Restart'; When complete computer will restart (While update is downloading, you can do the following tasks:

Click on **Notifications** in Menu Bar (upper right corner)

Click on 'One New' or 'Edit'... whichever appears in bottom central button

Click on red 'Minus' circles to remove all Notifications

Click 'Done/ Close Notifications

On Dock/

Click **Remote Buddy**

Click on Menu Bar/RemoteBuddy/Enter License Code

Find License information in Documents/Software/Remote Buddy

Enter information; Click Proceed; Click Verify; Click Done

Click on Preferences

Click on 'Mobile Access'; Set password to **blondes**

On Dock/

Click **WiFi On**, Wifi Connects and **Team Viewer** opens

Note Team Viewer 'Your ID'

In Team Viewer Preferences/Security, enter Password (**JeffreyBl0ndesF!lm***)

Confirm Password, click Apply,

In General Tab, ensure 'Start TeamViewer with System' is unchecked

In Advanced Tab, ensure 'Check for new version is set to 'Never'

Ensure 'Install new versions automatically is set to 'No automatic updates'

Close TeamViewer Preferences window

On Dock/

Click **WiFi Off**, Wifi disconnects and **Team Viewer** closes

On Dock/

Click **Open Keyboard and Network**, The first time only, you will need to give additional permissions in System Preferences/Security&Privacy: Click 'Open Anyway', Click 'Open' or 'Allow')

On Dock/

Click **Close Keyboard and Network**, The first time only, you will need to give additional permissions in System Preferences/Security&Privacy: Click 'Open Anyway', Click 'Open' or 'Allow')

On Dock/

Click on '**Open Film Directory**', The first time only, you will need to give additional permissions in System Preferences/Security&Privacy: Click 'Open Anyway', Click 'Open' or 'Allow')

Select Film Directory (Container of Film)

This will usually be the External Hard Drive called 'Blondes Playdisk',
Click 'Open'

On Dock/

Click on '**Open Preferences**', The first time only, you will need to give additional permissions in System Preferences/Security&Privacy: Click 'Open Anyway', Click 'Open' or 'Allow')

Set Startup 1, Set Shutdown 1

If user wishes to use two start and stop times (e.g. on in morning and off while away at work, then on in the evening, then off at bedtime), Check 'Use 2 schedules' box and set Startup 2 and Shutdown 2
Ensure 'Activate Shutdown is checked'
Close Settings window

On Dock/

Click on **JeffreyBlondes2** App, Ensure film starts

**Quit all programs,
Close all open windows,
Empty Trash, Clear Recent Menu Items**

RESTART COMPUTER

Alternative :

Connect USB keyboard and mouse
Connect Screen (via HDMI)
Connect to mains

Connect Archive Disk via USB

Start Mac Mini while holding down the ALT key of the keyboard

Select **RECOVERY**, click on Arrow; (Conversely, start MacMini with internal system, then go to System Preferences/StartUpDisk, unlock using the password '**blondes**', and select 'Recovery' from the window, click 'Restart'.)

If you are unable to start up computer from an external disk, follow instructions for giving permissions to do so. (Start computer while pushing 'command' and 'R', Select Language,

Method One:

Select 'Restore From Time Machine Backup', Follow instructions,
Choose 'Time Machine Catalina or appropriate disk for your computer

Method Two:

Menu Bar/Utilities/StartUp Security Utility, click on 'Enter macOS Password',
Enter (blondes), Click 'No Security', Click 'Allow booting from external media'
Restart computer **while holding down the ALT key of the keyboard**

Select **RECOVERY**, click on Arrow; (Conversely, start MacMini with internal system, then go to System Preferences/StartupDisk, unlock using the password '**blondes**', and select 'Recovery' from the window, click 'Restart'.)

Once computer started, use Tools to restore or clone BlondesApp2.0 onto internal Drive. Either Disk Utilities/Restore or Carbon Copy Cloner. User must be somewhat familiar with these processes to do correctly.

- Password for Recovery is '**blondes**'
 - On Disk 'TimeMachine', Open Disk Image of 'BlondesApp2.0...'
 - Disk appears on Desktop
 - Open Disk Utility
 - Select Computer's Internal HD
 - Click 'Restore'
 - Select Restore From 'BlondesApp2.0...'
- You may be required to enter a password. Password is '**blondes**'.

Allow Disk Utility to restore your Disk. When completed, quit and **RESTART COMPUTER** using the Internal Hard Drive (while computer is shut down, disconnect the Archive Disk. Alternately, hold down the ALT key of the keyboard and select the internal Hard Drive of the computer.)
